RIO HONDO POLICE DEPT. has adopted a detailed written policy on racial profiling. Our policy:

- 1) clearly defines acts constituting racial profiling;
- 2) strictly prohibits peace officers employed by the RIO HONDO POLICE DEPT. from engaging in racial profiling;
- 3) implements a process by which an individual may file a complaint with the RIO HONDO POLICE DEPT. if the individual believes that a peace officer employed by the RIO HONDO POLICE DEPT. has engaged in racial profiling with respect to the individual;
- 4) provides public education relating to the agency's complaint process;
- 5) requires appropriate corrective action to be taken against a peace officer employed by the RIO HONDO POLICE DEPT. who, after an investigation, is shown to have engaged in racial profiling in violation of the RIO HONDO POLICE DEPT. policy;
- 6) requires collection of information relating to motor vehicle stops in which a warning or citation is issued and to arrests made as a result of those stops, including information relating to:
 - a. the race or ethnicity of the individual detained;
 - b. whether a search was conducted and, if so, whether the individual detained consented to the search;
 - c. whether the peace officer knew the race or ethnicity of the individual detained before detaining that individual;
 - d. whether the peace officer used physical force that resulted in bodily injury during the stop;
 - e. the location of the stop;
 - f. the reason for the stop.
- 7) requires the chief administrator of the agency, regardless of whether the administrator is elected, employed, or appointed, to submit an annual report of the information collected under Subdivision (6) to:
 - a. the Commission on Law Enforcement; and
 - b. the governing body of each county or municipality served by the agency, if the agency is an agency of a county, municipality, or other political subdivision of the state.

The RIO HONDO POLICE DEPT. has satisfied the statutory data audit requirements as prescribed in Article 2.133(c),

Code of Criminal Procedure during the reporting period.

Dear Mr. Medina,

First and foremost, I would like to thank you, the Mayor and the City Councilmember's of Rio Hondo for the opportunity to serve the residents and commercial entities of the City of Rio Hondo with their solid waste needs. As part of our desire to continue to keep working together with the city and provide the services the community has become so accustomed to, we are providing you this letter with the offer of contract extension. With that in mind, I thank you in advance for giving us the opportunity to present you with this contract extension offer and hope that you will consider it. We look forward to continuing our partnership. As part of the offer of extension, we are currently and will continue to provide you as part of the extension offer 1X per week residential cart services and 1X per month brush/bulky services. The current contract expires on 7/31/2021.

Our contract extension offer is as below:

- 1. Current rates being provided would be held for one year. Therefore, Rio Hondo would not receive any price increases for the services being provided until August of 2022. ***See pricing below which reflects current rates.**
- 2. The current Annual Price Increases are capped at 6%. Republic Services is offering to lower the cap rate to 4%. This reduction in the price increase cap will help keep rates lower. Therefore, Annual Price increase would range from 0% to 4% MAX.**
- 3. Republic Services would commit to providing new carts to all Residential accounts at the start of year 1 of the contract. New carts would be as pictured below. The carts would bring a new look to the City of Rio Hondo!**
- 4. All aspects of the language, services and formalities as contained in the current contract would remain unchanged and in effect as well.**
