MINUTES FROM A REGULAR MEETING ON May 30, 2025

The Government Body of the City of Rio Hondo, Texas met in a Regular Meeting on May 30, 2025 at 6:00 pm in the Commission Chambers at City Hall, with Mayor- Gustavo Olivares Presiding- Present, Mayor, Present and Commissioners, Juan Garza- Present, Diana Bustamante-Zavala – Present, Esteban Bocanegra- Absent, Olga Gallegos- Present, and Jose Cavazos- Present

ALSO PRESENT: Ben Medina - City Administrator, Lucy Garza - Finance Director, Robert Drinkard - City Attorney, Chief Bilokury, Sgt Michael Rodriguez, Robert Snyder - Reserve Officer, Dan Sanchez - Attorney, Attorney Shergold, Residents: Mrs. Bilokury, Heather Horras, Guadalupe Medina, Zenaida Medina, Alonso Garza, Tony David, Kristi David, and David Reyes.

Regular Agenda:

1. Public Comment Period: Please Note – The Public Comment Period is designated for hearing concerns regarding City of Rio Hondo Public Policy or City of Rio Hondo business that is or is not on the Agenda or items listed on the agenda.

Resident Kristi David expressed her concerns regarding Chief Bilokury. She stated that she has been living here with no services. What she meant by this is that a few years ago she received a letter signed by Chief Bilokury stating that they would not receive any ambulance, fire, or police assistance unless there was 2 officers on duty, which is very rare. Ms. David stated this was in retaliation to a letter her husband wrote warning the City of Rio Hondo that Chief Bilokury was not of the integrity to hold said position. She added that her dog was shot while in kennel on her front porch. After, taking her dog to the vet were they did X-rays which showed a bullet, she called the PD. She stated she was asked a series of questions. One being "Do you have any enemies?" to which she responded "yes, your Chief Bilokury". She then obtained a police report made by Chief Bilokury which stated that she had threatened him when she read the Police Report it stated "dog shot" and that was their investigation. Ms. David stated that you would expect an investigation when there's a shooting but there wasn't. Since then the Davids have put a fence and tend to stay on their property since they don't feel safe, secure, and have no support.

Resident Alonso Garza addressed the Council stating he himself has been a victim because of Chief Bilokury. He stated he could have sued the City but didn't. He stated that it is time for a change and for the Commission to do this for the City of Rio Hondo. He stated that

later something bad can happen and the City will pay the consequences. Mr. Garza ended with stating to take it to heart and to make a decision, whether they like it or not, and do what is right for the City of Rio Hondo.

Resident Heather Horras expressed concern regarding Spotted Sea Trout Park in terms of safety. Bad issues with people walking on walking trail. Signs not working. She stated that we need to put something better than cones so that people don't drive on the trails. She constantly gets yelled at by people she calls out.

Resident Tony David started by thanking the commission for not allowing spot zoning in his neighborhood at previous meeting. Mr. David then went on to say that regarding what his wife Kristi David had stated he never filed a complaint because as he has stated before he just wants to be left alone. But it has been a lot of years, and he did warn previous commissioners. He stated that on the police report Chief Bilokury called his wife passive aggressive. "He's not a psychologist to say she is passive aggressive". He added that Chief Bilokury called the Texas Rangers on him for no reason and he has a witness which is Mark Garcia. Mr. David stated he knows of 2 individuals that were arrested but charges were never filed. Mr. David said "What you do in a community – policing – will have an effect for a generation". Mr. David said he will never forget what was done to him and neither will his 2 sons. Mr. David said there was so much more he could say but not enough time.

Attorney John Shergold introduced himself to the council as representing Chief Bilokury. He added that Chief Bilokury has requested that item 2 be discussed in the open public. He also, if there is any action taken against his client, he is protected under the Texas Whistleblower Statue for retaliation for making a report.

Attorney Dan Sanchez introduced himself to the council as Mr. Ben Medina's attorney. He stated that Mr. Medina has been a victim of Chief Bilokury's actions. Mr. Medina was arrested, bonded out, and had to hire him as his attorney. All of this has had a big impact on Mr. Medina. Mr. Sanchez asked the Council to remember they are the gatekeepers of justice in this community and they are the ones that need to make it clear that no one is above the law. Mr. Sanchez told the council to consider that when making their decision and send a message to this community that they can count them as elected officials.

2. Executive Session: Deliberation of the appointment, employment, evaluation, reassignment, duties, discipline, or dismissal of the Police Chief/Public Safety Director pursuant to Texas Government Code Section 551.074, unless the employee elects to have the deliberation in open session.

Commissioner Cavazos made a motion to go into Executive Session under Government Code 551.071- Consultation with Attorney. Commissioner Gallegos seconded the motion, all voted "aye" to approve; motion carried.

Mr. Shergold asked the Council for this item to be tabled so that he can discuss with Mr. Drinkard but in the case that adverse personnel action is taken against Chief Bilokury he will take the position that this is retaliation for him doing his job. His client position is simple he reported unlawful action by one of the city's employees. If he is terminated we will be in court within 60 days from the time of his termination. Mr. Shergold added that his client did the right thing. Again, Mr. Shergold asked for this item to be tabled so that his client have the opportunity to speak with legal representative for the city. He added that if his client was to be fired it would look as it if it was rushed and not done fairly.

Commissioner Garza made a motion to go into Executive Session under Government Code 551.071 – Consultation with Attorney. Commissioner Cavazos seconded the motion, all voted "aye" to approve; motion carried

3. Consideration and Action on the appointment, employment, evaluation, reassignment, duties, discipline, or dismissal of the Police Chief/Public Safety Director.

Mayor addressed the council and citizens in attendance that the decision they are about to make was not made from one day to another. He added that the city hired an investigator. The investigation took months. The Mayor also said that he received letters from several staff members that have concerns being here.

Commissioner Cavazos commented that there were several violations that were committed. There were several cases that were not properly investigated.

Commissioner Cavazos made a motion for the immediate dismissal of Police Chief/Public Safety Director. Commissioner Garza seconded the motion.

4. Consideration and Action on the appointment or employment of a temporary/interim Police Chief/Public Safety Director.

Mr. Medina recommended Ms. Olga Maldonado as interim Police Chief effective immediately. She is retired Chief of Police for City of Mercedes and is currently the Mayor of La Feria.

Commissioner Cavazos stated that he would like to hire within the department. He recommended Sgt. Rodriguez.

Mayor asked Sgt Rodriguez if he would be interested being Interim Chief. He stated that given the situation that is happening in the City we need someone neutral.

Sgt. Rodriguez replied that he is interested and that he is here for the City.

Mayor added that whoever they select will also be running the Fire Dept. He again asked

the Seargent if he would still be interested.

Sgt Rodriguez replied that he would help the City until they hire someone but as far as a permanent position he is not interested in running the Fire Dept even though he is ceritified.

Mr. Medina stated his vision was to bring someone from the outside. He added that Ms. Maldonado would define the roles of Police Chief and Fire Chief.

Commissioner Cavazos stated that bringing in Ms. Maldonado would be replacing the Chief instead of reducing staff even more.

Sgt Rodriguez stated that they are very short staffed. The Police Dept has just lost Officer Ingle & Officer Ball and now the Chief. The Police Dept is short 4 officers.

Commissioner Garza questioned if Ms. Maldonado would be handling the Fire Dept. there was discussion regarding amongst commissioner regarding this topic. Commissioner Cavazos added that although she is not certified to run Fire which is the purpose of the Assistant Fire Chief plus we also have Sgt Rodriguez. Therefore, Ms. Maldonado can still be the Public Safety Director

Commissioner Cavazos made a motion to appoint Ms. Olga Maldonado as temporary/interim Police Chief/Public Safety Director. Commissioner Bustamente-Zavala seconded the motion, all voted "aye" to approve; motion carried.



RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF RIO HONDO, TEXAS AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING PUBLICATION OF NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ISSUE CERTIFICATES OF OBLIGATION; COMPLYING WITH THE REQUIREMENTS CONTAINED IN SECURITIES AND EXCHANGE COMMISSION RULE 15c2-12; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City Commission (the City Commission) of the City of Rio Hondo, Texas (the City) has determined that it is advisable and necessary to issue and sell one or more series of certificates of obligation (the Certificates) in an amount not to exceed \$4,150,000 as provided pursuant to the provisions of the Certificate of Obligation Act of 1971, as amended, Texas Local Government Code, Section 271.041 through Section 271.064, for the purpose of paying contractual obligations of the City to be incurred for making permanent public improvements and for other public purposes, to-wit: (1) constructing, acquiring, purchasing, renovating, enlarging, and improving City administrative facilities housing the governmental functions of the City, including renovations and improvements to City Hall, the City Library, and the City's workforce development building; (2) constructing, acquiring, purchasing, renovating, enlarging, and improving City public safety facilities and signage, including renovations to the police department and fire department; (3) designing, demolishing, constructing, renovating, improving, reconstructing, restructuring and extending streets and thoroughfares and related land and rightof-way sidewalks, streetscapes, collectors, drainage, landscape, signage, acquiring lands and rights-of-way necessary thereto or incidental therewith; (4) constructing, acquiring, purchasing, renovating, enlarging, and improving City park facilities, including Rio Hondo City Park; (5) acquiring vehicles and equipment for various City departments, including a street sweeper and a skid steer loader; (6) the purchase of materials, supplies, equipment, machinery, landscaping, land, and rights-of-way for authorized needs and purposes; and (7) payment for professional services relating to the design, construction, project management, and financing of the aforementioned projects; and

WHEREAS, prior to the offering, sale, and issuance of the Certificates, the appropriate officials of the City must review and approve the distribution of a "deemed final" preliminary official statement (the *Official Statement*) in order to comply with the requirements contained in 17 C.F.R. §240.15c2-12 (the *Securities and Exchange Commission Rule*); and

WHEREAS, based upon their review of the Official Statement, the appropriate officials of the City must find to the best of their knowledge and belief, after reasonable investigation, that the representations of facts pertaining to the City contained in the Official Statement are true and correct and that, except as disclosed in the Official Statement, there are no facts pertaining to the City that would adversely affect the issuance of the Certificates or the City's ability to pay the debt service requirements on the Certificates when due; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission will comply with the requirements contained in the Securities and Exchange Commission Rule concerning the creation of a contractual obligation between the City and the proposed purchaser(s) of the Certificates (the *Purchasers*) to provide the

Purchasers with an Official Statement in a time and manner that will enable the Purchasers to comply with the distribution requirements and continuing disclosure requirements contained in the Securities and Exchange Commission Rule; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission authorizes the Mayor, City Administrator, City Secretary, and the City Attorney, as appropriate, or their designees, to review, approve, and execute any document or certificate in order to allow the City to comply with the requirements contained in the Securities and Exchange Commission Rule; and

WHEREAS, prior to the issuance of the Certificates, the City Commission is required to publish notice of its intention to issue the Certificates in a newspaper of general circulation in the City, and if the City maintains an internet website, publish such notice of intent on the City's internet website, such notice stating (i) the time and place the City Commission tentatively proposes to pass the ordinance authorizing the issuance of the Certificates, (ii) the purposes for which the Certificates are to be issued, (iii) the manner in which the City Commission proposes to pay the Certificates; (iv) the then-current principal amount of all outstanding ad valorem debt obligations of the City; (v) the then-current combined principal and interest required to pay all outstanding ad valorem debt obligations of the City on time and in full, which may be based on the City's expectations relative to the interest due on any variable rate ad valorem debt obligations; (vi) the maximum principal amount of the Certificates to be authorized; (vii) the estimated interest rate for the Certificates to be authorized or that the maximum interest rate for the Certificates may not exceed the maximum legal interest rate; and (viii) the maximum maturity date of the Certificates to be authorized; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission hereby finds and determines that such documents pertaining to the sale of the Certificates should be approved, and the City should proceed with the giving of notice of intention to issue the Certificates in the time, form, and manner provided by law; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission hereby finds and determines that the adoption of this Resolution is in the best interests of the residents of the City; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF RIO HONDO, TEXAS THAT:

SECTION 1. The City Secretary is hereby authorized and directed to cause notice to be published of the City Commission's intention to issue the Certificates in an amount not to exceed \$4,150,000 for the purpose of paying contractual obligations of the City to be incurred for making permanent public improvements and for other public purposes, to-wit: (1) constructing, acquiring, purchasing, renovating, enlarging, and improving City administrative facilities housing the governmental functions of the City, including renovations and improvements to City Hall, the City Library, and the City's workforce development building; (2) constructing, acquiring, purchasing, renovating, enlarging, and improving City public safety facilities and signage, including renovations to the police department and fire department; (3) designing, demolishing, constructing, renovating, improving, reconstructing, restructuring and extending streets and thoroughfares and related land and right-of-way sidewalks, streetscapes, collectors, drainage, landscape, signage, acquiring lands and rights-of-way necessary thereto or incidental therewith; (4) constructing,

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acquiring, purchasing, renovating, enlarging, and improving City park facilities, including Rio Hondo City Park; (5) acquiring vehicles and equipment for various City departments, including a street sweeper and a skid steer loader; (6) the purchase of materials, supplies, equipment, machinery, landscaping, land, and rights-of-way for authorized needs and purposes; and (7) payment for professional services relating to the design, construction, project management, and financing of the aforementioned projects. The Certificates will be payable from the levy of an annual ad valorem tax, within the limitations prescribed by law, upon all taxable property within the City and additionally from a pledge of and lien on certain revenues derived from the operation of the City's utility system. The notice hereby approved and authorized to be published shall read substantially in the form and content of Exhibit A attached hereto, which notice is incorporated herein by reference as a part of this Resolution for all purposes.

SECTION 2. The City Secretary shall cause the notice described in Section 1 to be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City, once a week for two consecutive weeks, the date of the first publication shall be at least forty-six (46) days prior to the date stated therein for passage of the ordinance authorizing the issuance of the Certificates. Additionally, the City Secretary shall cause the notice described in Section 1 to be posted continuously on the City's website for at least forty-five (45) days prior to the date stated therein for passage of the ordinance authorizing the issuance of the Certificates.

SECTION 3. The Mayor, City Administrator, City Secretary, and the City Attorney, as appropriate, or their designees, are authorized to review and approve the Official Statement pertaining to the offering, sale, and issuance of the Certificates and to execute any document or certificate in order to comply with the requirements contained in the Securities and Exchange Commission Rule.

SECTION 4. The recitals contained in the preamble hereof are hereby found to be true, and such recitals are hereby made a part of this Resolution for all purposes and are adopted as a part of the judgment and findings of the City Commission.

SECTION 5. All ordinances and resolutions, or parts thereof, which are in conflict or inconsistent with any provision of this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, and the provisions of this Resolution shall be and remain controlling as to the matters resolved herein.

SECTION 6. This Resolution shall be construed and enforced in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas and the United States of America.

SECTION 7. If any provision of this Resolution or the application thereof to any person or circumstance shall be held to be invalid, the remainder of this Resolution and the application of such provision to other persons and circumstances shall nevertheless be valid, and the City Commission hereby declares that this Resolution would have been enacted without such invalid provision.

SECTION 8. It is officially found, determined, and declared that the meeting at which this Resolution is adopted was open to the public and public notice of the time, place, and subject

matter of the public business to be considered at such meeting, including this Resolution, was given, all as required by Chapter 551, as amended, Texas Government Code.

SECTION 9. This Resolution shall be in force and effect from and after the date of its adoption, and it is so resolved.

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ISSUE CITY OF RIO HONDO, TEXAS CERTIFICATES OF OBLIGATION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Commission of the City of Rio Hondo, Texas will convene at its regular meeting place in the City Hall in Rio Hondo, Texas, at 6:00 o'clock P.M., Rio Hondo, Texas time on August 19, 2025, and, during such meeting, the City Commission will consider the passage of an ordinance or ordinances and take such other actions as may be deemed necessary to authorize the issuance of one or more series of certificates of obligation in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$4,150,000 for the purpose or purposes of paying contractual obligations of the City to be incurred for making permanent public improvements and for other public purposes, to-wit: (1) constructing, acquiring, purchasing, renovating, enlarging, and improving City administrative facilities housing the governmental functions of the City, including renovations and improvements to City Hall, the City Library, and the City's workforce development building; (2) constructing, acquiring, purchasing, renovating, enlarging, and improving City public safety facilities and signage, including renovations to the police department and fire department; (3) designing, demolishing, constructing, renovating, improving, reconstructing, restructuring and extending streets and thoroughfares and related land and right-of-way sidewalks, streetscapes, collectors, drainage, landscape, signage, acquiring lands and rights-of-way necessary thereto or incidental therewith; (4) constructing, acquiring, purchasing, renovating, enlarging, and improving City park facilities, including Rio Hondo City Park; (5) acquiring vehicles and equipment for various City departments, including a street sweeper and a skid steer loader; (6) the purchase of materials, supplies, equipment, machinery, landscaping, land, and rights-of-way for authorized needs and purposes; and (7) payment for professional services relating to the design, construction, project management, and financing of the aforementioned projects. The certificates of obligation (the Certificates) will be payable from the levy of an annual ad valorem tax, within the limitations prescribed by law, upon all taxable property within the City and from a lien on and pledge of certain revenues derived by the City from the operation of the City's utility system. In accordance with Section 271.049, as amended, Texas Local Government Code: (i) the current principal amount of all of the City's outstanding public securities secured by and payable from ad valorem taxes is \$797,000; (ii) the current combined principal and interest required to pay all of the City's outstanding public securities secured by and payable from ad valorem taxes on time and in full is \$958,013; (iii) the estimated combined principal and interest required to pay the Certificates to be authorized on time and in full is \$6,928,103; (iv) the maximum interest rate for the Certificates may not exceed the maximum legal interest rate; and (v) the maximum maturity date of the Certificates to be authorized is August 1, 2045. The Certificates are to be issued, and this notice is given, under and pursuant to the provisions of the Certificate of Obligation Act of 1971, as amended, Texas Local Government Code Section 271.041 through Section 271.064, Chapter 1502, as amended, Texas Government Code.
