**Public Works**

All of the equipment is working. Our City/County Park and City Hall park are open at 75% capacity and scheduling has started.

We will start the expansion of internet services to the park and civic center since the grant funds arrived on Tuesday.

The Mesquite Street reconstruction by Rhyner Construction has started and the drainage is being installed.

Sale tax is on par with other months see attached report

Water Tower has a leak, and the repair is being contracted. Staff has tried to fix it but it beyond our capabilities.

The sewer lift station pumps installation is being bid.

**Library**

The City Library will be retrofitting all of the light fixtures with the assistance of Cameron County Library System.

The Library is averaging 12-25 patrons a day and increase in the last month.

### **Senior Center**

The Senior Center continues to bundle meals. The Center is feeding 65 senior citizens every week. There will be vaccinations for all seniors receiving meals.

RIO HONDO POLICE DEPT. has adopted a detailed written policy on racial profiling. Our policy:

- 1) clearly defines acts constituting racial profiling;
- 2) strictly prohibits peace officers employed by the RIO HONDO POLICE DEPT. from engaging in racial profiling;
- 3) implements a process by which an individual may file a complaint with the RIO HONDO POLICE DEPT. if the individual believes that a peace officer employed by the RIO HONDO POLICE DEPT. has engaged in racial profiling with respect to the individual;
- 4) provides public education relating to the agency's complaint process;
- 5) requires appropriate corrective action to be taken against a peace officer employed by the RIO HONDO POLICE DEPT. who, after an investigation, is shown to have engaged in racial profiling in violation of the RIO HONDO POLICE DEPT. policy;
- 6) requires collection of information relating to motor vehicle stops in which a warning or citation is issued and to arrests made as a result of those stops, including information relating to:
  - a. the race or ethnicity of the individual detained;
  - b. whether a search was conducted and, if so, whether the individual detained consented to the search;
  - c. whether the peace officer knew the race or ethnicity of the individual detained before detaining that individual;
  - d. whether the peace officer used physical force that resulted in bodily injury during the stop;
  - e. the location of the stop;
  - f. the reason for the stop.
- 7) requires the chief administrator of the agency, regardless of whether the administrator is elected, employed, or appointed, to submit an annual report of the information collected under Subdivision (6) to:
  - a. the Commission on Law Enforcement; and
  - b. the governing body of each county or municipality served by the agency, if the agency is an agency of a county, municipality, or other political subdivision of the state.

The RIO HONDO POLICE DEPT. has satisfied the statutory data audit requirements as prescribed in Article 2.133(c),

Code of Criminal Procedure during the reporting period.
